Frequently Asked Questions about PAFTE

1. What is PAFTE?	PAFTE is the Philippine Association for Teachers and Educators, a non-stock, non-profit, organization of teachers and educators.
2. What are the purposes of the organization?	a) Promotes and maintains unity, professionalism among teacher educators, Teacher Education Institutions and professional teachers. b) Raises and maintains standards of education. c) Stimulates, supports and undertakes research studies, scholarly works and organizations d) Serves as partner of the Philippine government in promoting national development thru pre-service and inservice education
3. What are the types of membership?	Institutional Individual membership (LIFE, REGULAR, ASSOCIATE) Honorary
4. Who is a regular member?	A licensed teacher, professor, administrator or any person who is professionally involved in teacher education and possesses Master's degree
5. Who is an associate member?	A teacher who possesses the qualifications of a regular member but has not earned Master's degree.
6. What are the qualifications for a lifetime membership?	a) A regular member for at least 3 years b) Has attended at least 1 national convention. c) Be recommended by the National Board
7. How much is the membership fee?	Regular/ Associate membership Php 400.00 annually Lifetime membership Php 5,000.00 Institutional membership Php 2,000.00 good for 3 years

8. What is the coverage of the annual membership?	Membership is from June 1 to May 31 covering a 12-month period.
9. How can one enlist for individual membership?	Accomplish membership form. Individual membership is done by regions. The regional board approves the application for membership. Pay the membership thru the BDO UN Avenue Philippine Association for Teachers and Educators (PAFTE), Inc Account No.000 560 358 458 Scan receipt , indicate complete name and region and send to account@pafteorg.onmicrosoft.com.
10. What are the requirements of membership to PAFTE?	a) Accomplished individual registration form b) Photocopy of PRC ID c) membership fee
11. How much is the lifetime membership fee?	Php 5,000.00
12. Who is an institutional member?	It is an institution, college, school or department which offers pre-service and in-service teacher education.
13. How much is the institutional membership?	Php 2,000 covering a three-year period.
	A certificate of membership is given to the institution.
14. When is the election of the National and Regional officers?	They must be elected to office prior to the first day of June of each fiscal year.
15. What is the term of office of the elected officers?	The officers shall be elected for a term of 2 years and may be re-elected for another term but not to serve more than two consecutive terms.
16. What are the qualifications of the national president and regional chair?	The President or Regional Chair should be the incumbent Dean or its equivalent of the College of Education.

17. Who are qualified to be elected as Board of Directors?	a) Regular member of good standing for no less than yearsb) Endorsed by the regional chapterc) Has attended at least three (3) national conventions
18. Can we elect two officers from the same institution/ branch?	Representation to the Board / Region is limited to one slot per institution.
19. Who are the officers of the national / Regional board?	 President/ Chair Vice President / vice Chair Secretary Assistant Secretary Treasurer Auditor PRO
20. Who are qualified to vote?	Regular, life and institutional members of good standing are entitled to one vote. Institutional member is entitled to (2) votes
